## You may qualify for the FCC Emergency Broadband Benefit Program!

### What is the FCC Emergency Broadband Benefit Program?

The FCC Emergency Broadband Benefit Program is a temporary relief program to assist families during the COVID-19 pandemic and help them connect to online resources such as telehealth, virtual learning and remote work at a discounted rate.

### What kind of discount can I expect?

Through the program, eligible households qualify for \$50 a month off internet service through WK&T. Funds are nontransferable and limited to one per household.

### What are the eligibility requirements?

To qualify, a member of your household must meet one of the following requirements:

- Eligible for Lifeline
- Receives benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch or breakfast program
- Experienced a substantial, documented loss of income since Feb. 29, 2020
- Received a Federal Pell Grant in the current award year

### How does WK&T help?

WK&T has chosen to participate in the program to help those in the communities they serve who need it most. WK&T will offer eligible households a discounted rate on fiber-fast internet during the benefit program. Customers are subject to WK&T's regular rates, terms and conditions once the program ends.

### WK&T offers the following speeds with no data caps:

- 100/100 Mbps — \$39.90
- 250/250 Mbps — \$59.90
- 500/500 Mbps — \$79.90
- 1/1 Gig — \$99.90
- Managed Wi-Fi — \$3.00

Pricing above reflects monthly rates after EBBP discount is applied.

### How do I sign up?

### How long does the program last?

The program will be available until the fund is expended or six months after the COVID-19 health emergency ends.
